Tents and cooking equipment will be provided. Some other equipment (listed below) can be provided if required e.g. rucksacks, sleeping bags, roll mats etc. However this equipment may need to be borrowed from District Stores or other groups so any requirements for equipment need to be identified early on.

Smaller items of personal equipment need to be provided by the participants themselves. Advice regarding the suitability of own equipment and selection of new items can be obtained from any of the group leaders.
